Subject:- Grant of Yearly Permission Sri Sri College of Ayurvedic Science and Research Hospital, Sri Sri University, Bidyadharpur, Arilo, Ward No. 3, Cuttack-754006, Odisha (Inst. ID:- AYU0635) with intake capacity of 66 seats (instead of 100 seats) in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2026-27 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 reg.

Sir/Madam,

- 1) To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Sri Sri College of Ayurvedic Science and Research Hospital, Sri Sri University, Bidyadharpur, Arilo, Ward No. 3, Cuttack-754006, Odisha (Inst. ID:- AYU0635)** inspection was conducted on **11.05.2026 and 12.05.2026** in hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the permission with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2026-27 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.
- 2) The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2024", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder. **On careful examination of the assessment report and as per the visitor observation certain the shortcomings/defects were observed** and the same was placed in the **165th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **24.07.2026**. Board discussed and decided to seek Clarification from the college regarding the shortcomings observed during the assessment.
- 3) Further, in adherence to the principles of natural justice, an opportunity of clarification vide letter even no. dated **31.07.2026** was provided to you. In response of the same you have submitted the clarification vide ref. no. **SSCASRH/SSU/493-2026** dated **04.08.2026**.
- 4) The clarification report was placed in the **172nd Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on **18.08.2026** and Board concluded that the college is not fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulations. However, Board decided to issue yearly permission in accordance with regulation 54 (3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda regulations, 2024, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and as per the Punitive Policy in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 for failing to maintain the minimum essential standards for the Academic year 2026-27.
❖ As per the "Punitive Policy for the academic session 2026-27"
i) "For each deficient teaching faculty, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 5% of total intake capacity."

There is shortcoming of 01 Lower faculty in the department of Ayurved Samhita & Siddhanta, 01 lower faculty in the department of Rachna Sharir, 01 Higher faculty in the department of Roga Nidan Evam Vikriti Vigyana, 01 Higher faculty in the department of Agad Tantra Avum Vidhi Vidyaka, 01 Higher faculty in the department of Shalakya Tantra and 1 Lower faculty in the department Kaumarbhritya.

Therefore seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 30% of total intake capacity (i.e. Reduction of 30 seats).

- ii) "For Deficiency in Hospital staff (excluding group D staff) seat reduction in intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake capacity as under:-

For non-availability of nursing staff seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 1 seat per 03 deficient staff.

As total 12 nursing staffs are not available, Therefore seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 04 seats.

Therefore seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the 04 Seats of total intake capacity (i.e. Reduction of 04 seats).

Accordingly, after applying the seat reduction policy 2026-27 under section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020, college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of yearly permission with intake capacity of 66 seats [instead of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2026-27 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.

"DECISION"

- 5) **Yearly Permission is hereby granted to Sri Sri College of Ayurvedic Science and Research Hospital, Sri Sri University, Bidyadharpur, Arilo, Ward No. 3, Cuttack-754006, Odisha (Inst. ID:- AYU0635) with 66 seats (instead of 100 seats) in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2026-27 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 .**
- 6) **Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
- 7) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 8) **Compliance report of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the implementation letters vide ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS dated 09.05.2024 and 06.09.2024 issued by the board.**
- 9) **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31st December, 2026 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2027-28 :-**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
- 10) The fulfilment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2027-28.
- 11) Further, in case you are not satisfied with the decision of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM, you may prefer an appeal as per regulation 65(1) of MESAR UG (Ayurveda) 2024.

Note:- It is also noted that, if the concerned University does not grant affiliation to the college or withdraws the affiliation, the permission granted by MARBISM shall automatically stand withdrawn without any further notice or order.
