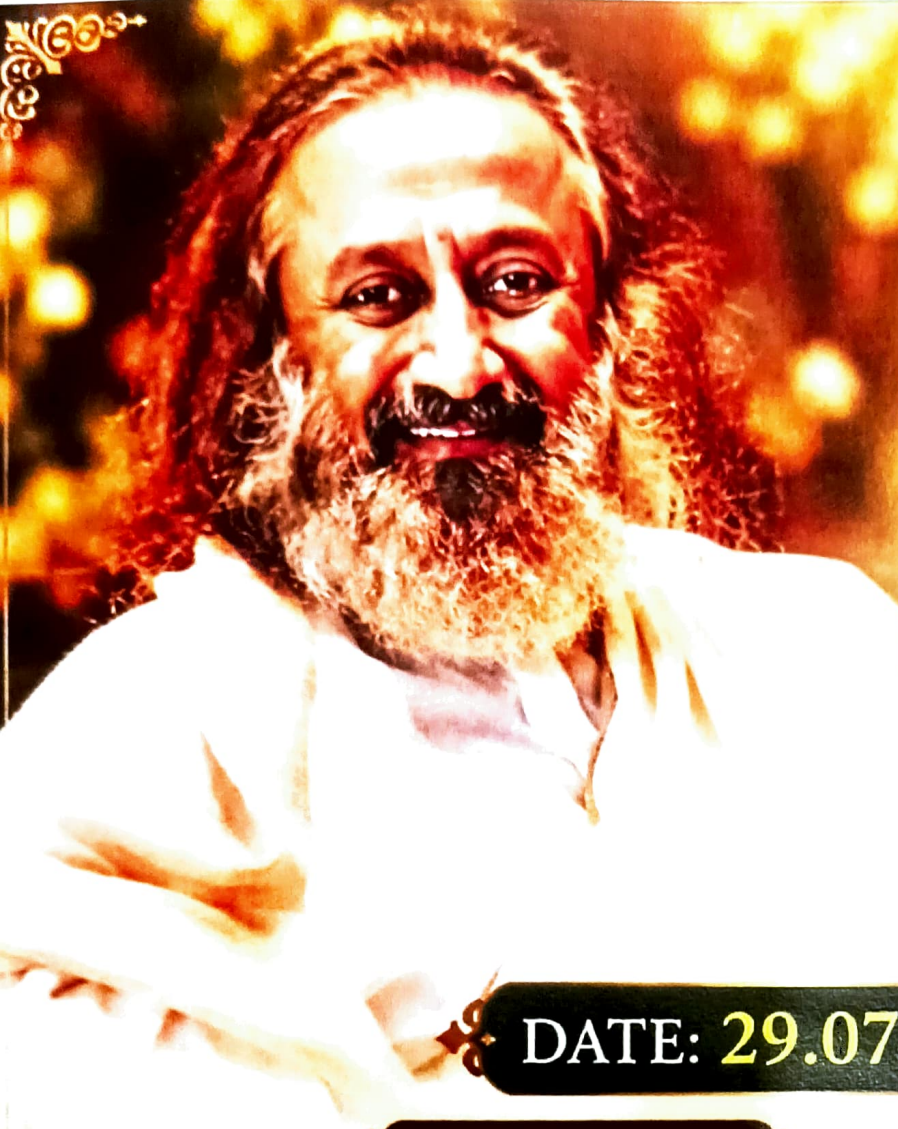

May their wisdom continue to inspire us always.



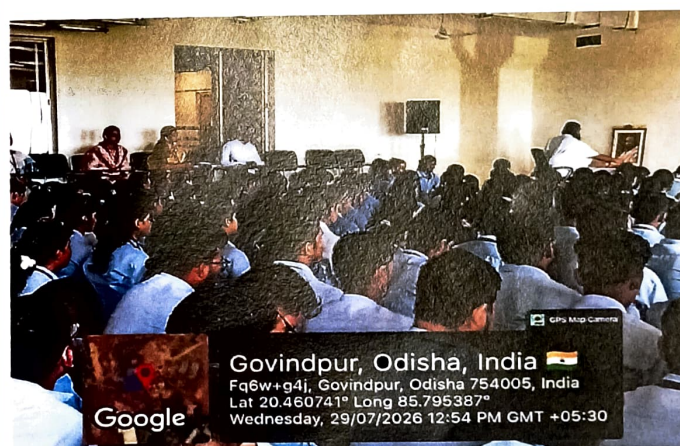
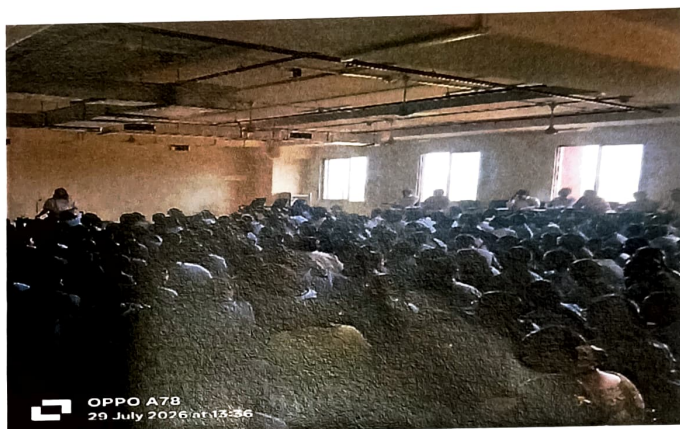
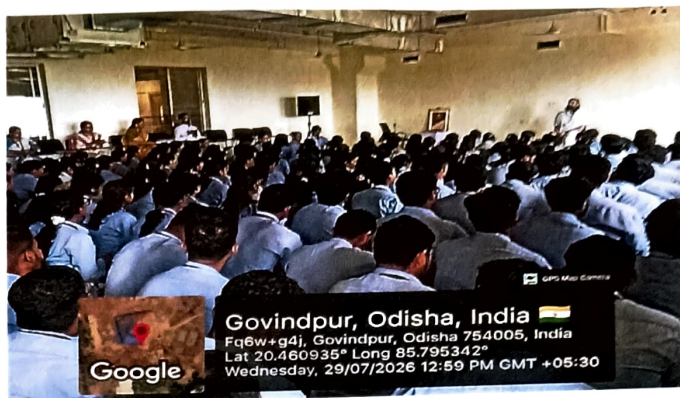
